

Voglibose can Treat Postprandial Reactive Hypoglycemia, Suppress Oxidative Stress and Prevent Endothelial Dysfunction.

- In postprandial reactive hypoglycaemia, administration of low-dose voglibose (alpha-glucosidase inhibitor), improved the glucose fluctuations and inhibited hypoglycemic symptoms.
- The above may be attributed to its ability to prevent endothelial dysfunction by suppressing oxidative stress.

Voglibose might effectively prevent hypoglycemic symptoms and endothelial dysfunction by suppressing oxidative stress.
