WORLD DIABETES DAY 2023

It serves as a platform to collectively and individually address the need for improved prevention, diagnosis, and management of this condition. The focus extends to advocating for equitable access to essential care, with an emphasis on raising awareness about ways individuals with diabetes can reduce their risk of complications.

As part of its commitment, Blue Cross organized various activities, including **New Patient Detection Camps** held across India in collaboration with like-minded doctors. These camps played a vital role in the early detection of numerous new diabetic patients. Aligning with the spirit of World Diabetes Day, these activities aim to celebrate the experiences of individuals with all forms of diabetes and encourage proactive measures, such as seeking and obtaining essential care.

This year, the unique timing of World Diabetes Day, coinciding with Diwali, prompted the scheduling of these camps on 16th November in most locations. The thoughtful coordination of such events not only underscores the importance of diabetes awareness but also demonstrates a dedicated effort to reach and support individuals impacted by diabetes in the community.













NUTRITION IN ALLERGIC DISEASE

Nutrition plays a crucial role in the management of allergic diseases, which are disorders resulting from abnormal immune responses to allergens. Common symptoms include red itchy eyes, sneezing, nasal congestion, leaky nose, coughing, and itchy or swollen skin. Allergic reactions are triggered by the release of histamine when the body comes



into contact with specific allergens.

Dietary factors not only influence the development of allergic diseases but also impact the course and severity of these conditions. Seasonal allergies, in particular, can be addressed through dietary modifications. Different dietary components are associated with various allergy outcomes. For instance, high intake of energy, saturated fat, protein, and low fiber may increase allergy risk. On the other hand, a diet rich in vegetables, fruits, olive oil, and fish has been linked to a lower risk of developing allergic diseases.

Managing allergies can be challenging, and while over-thecounter antihistamines provide temporary relief, incorporating specific foods into the diet can help reduce symptoms. A healthy diet can alleviate inflammation and sinus congestion, decreasing the frequency of allergy attacks. Adequate intake of micronutrients is also associated with a lower risk of allergic symptoms.

An anti-inflammatory diet is key to reducing the frequency of allergy symptoms. Incorporating the following elements into the diet can have anti-inflammatory effects:

- **1.** Omega-3-rich foods: Foods high in omega-3 fatty acids, such as salmon and tuna, can relieve inflammation and help alleviate allergy symptoms. Omega-3 supplements are also beneficial for preventing recurrent allergic attacks.
- **2. Vitamin C:** Acting as a natural antihistamine, vitamin C can reduce allergic rhinitis symptoms. Leafy vegetables like spinach, kale, and citrus fruits such as oranges are rich sources of vitamin C.
- **3. Zinc:** Found in red meats, poultry, nuts, whole grains, breakfast cereals, and dairy products, zinc has anti-inflammatory properties and can help reduce the severity and duration of allergic symptoms.
- **4. Spices:** Natural spices like turmeric, ginger, and garlic have anti-inflammatory properties that reduce allergy symptoms. Turmeric, containing curcumin, can block the release of histamine in the body.
- **5. Probiotics:** Supporting digestive health, probiotics regulate the immune system, decrease inflammation, and alleviate allergy symptoms. Yoghurt is a good source of probiotics, and supplements can also be consumed.
- **6. Water:** Staying hydrated is essential in reducing allergic symptoms. Dehydration can trigger histamine production, leading to allergy symptoms. Drinking sufficient water helps flush out the system and reduce histamine production.

While medications provide relief, maintaining a proper diet is essential for long-term allergy management. Identifying and eliminating triggers, along with incorporating anti-inflammatory foods, can reduce the severity and duration of symptoms. Nutritional therapy holds promise as a primary or supportive treatment for managing allergic symptoms.


