## MANAGING BLOOD PRESSURE



Hypertension is quite common and typically develops over the course of several years. It is called as a 'Silent Killer', because usually the symptoms go unnoticed. Hence, early detection is important because even without symptoms, high blood pressure can cause damage to your blood vessels and other vital organs.

## Points to remember:-

- The chance of having high blood pressure increases as you age.
- Some people are genetically predisposed to hypertension.
- Individuals diagnosed with either diabetes or metabolic syndromes are at a higher risk of developing hypertension.
- Most of the people with high blood pressure don't have signs or symptoms.
- Serious health problems can develop if high blood pressure is left untreated.


## $\rightarrow$ UNDERSTAND READINGS

Make smart choices and swaps to build an overall healthy eating style. Watch calories and eat smaller
 portions. Blood pressure is typically recorded as two numbers, written as a ratio like this:

## SYS TOLIC:

The top number, the higher of the two numbers, measures the pressure in the arteries when the heart beats (when the heart muscle contracts).
DIASTOLIC: The bottom number, the lower of the two numbers, measures the pressure in the arteries when the heart is resting between heart beats.

## $\rightarrow$ TRACK LEVELS

A diagnosis of high blood pressure must be confirmed with a health care professional. Any unusually low blood pressure readings should also be evaluated. Health care professionals can take blood pressure readings and provide recommendations.

## TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- EAT SMART : Eat a healthy diet of vegetables, fruits, whole grains, beans, legumes, nuts, plant-based proteins, lean animal proteins like fish and seafood.
- MOVE MORE: Physical activity helps control blood pressure, weight and stress levels
- MANAGE WEIGHT : If you're overweight, even a slight weight loss can reduce high blood pressure
- NO NICOTINE: Every time you smoke, vape or use tobacco, the nicotine can cause a temporary increase in blood pressure
- SLEEP WELL: Short sleep (less than 7 hours) and poorquality sleep are associated with high blood pressure.
