Optimal statin use for prevention of sepsis in type 2 diabetes mellitus *Sun M, et al. Diabetol Metab Syndr.* 2023; 15: 75.

- Patients with diabetes are more likely to have wounds and sores that do not heal and may become infected, leading to sepsis.
- The present study found that overall, statin users had a lower prevalence of sepsis than did nonusers.
- Compared with the patients not using statins, those using statins exhibited a more significant reduction in sepsis.
- Sepsis risk was significantly decreased in the statin users regardless of age, gender, antidiabetic drugs, coexisting comorbidities and medication use.
