## Amoxicillin and clavulanate potassium combination is a safe and effective option for treating children with suppurative tonsillitis.

- A clinical study evaluated effects of a 5-7 day course of the amoxicillin- clavulanate potassium combination in the treatment of 146 children with suppurative tonsillitis.
- The overall response rate of the amoxicillin and clavulanate potassium group was 94.52%, along with an improvement of white blood cell (WBC) count and C-reactive protein (CRP) levels.
- No severe adverse reactions were observed.
